6Hx19-1.35 NOTIFICATION OF REGISTERED SEXUAL OFFENDERS/PREDATORS

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish Board policy relating to notification to the College community regarding registered sexual offenders or predators.

In accordance with the Federal Campus Sex Crimes Prevention Act and Florida Law, the College shall notify all students, faculty and staff of the presence of registered sexual offenders/predators attending, employed, or carrying on a vocation at any campus of the College. This notice may be made in any manner acceptable under Federal or Florida Law and shall apply only when the College has received specific notice of such presence. The College shall also issue a statement advising the campus community where information concerning registered sex offenders may be obtained.

The College shall provide specific notice under this Rule to all youth camps, coordinators of any programs on campus involving minor children, and to the management of childcare centers located on PHSC campuses.
