6Hx19-6.38 DEFERMENT OF TUITION, FEES, AND PAYMENT FOR BOOKS FOR RECIPIENTS OF FEDERAL OR STATE FINANCIAL AID

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish Board policy regarding the deferring of payment for tuition, fees, and books for students eligible to receive federal or state financial aid.

When students are determined to be eligible for federal or state financial aid, but their financial aid cannot be awarded due to extenuating circumstances, tuition and fees may be deferred and payment for necessary books may be delayed up to 60 days, but not beyond 10 days before the end of the term to which the fees apply.

The District Financial Aid Office is responsible for determining the student's financial aid eligibility, granting the deferments, and securing proper deferment authorization.

Any student whose financial aid is rescinded or who becomes otherwise ineligible is liable for payment of deferred fees and book charges. Financial aid students who fail to meet financial obligations will have "holds" placed on their records and will not be allowed to reregister or receive transcripts until the deferments are paid in full.
