

6Hx19-1.25 SAFETY AND EMERGENCY PLANS

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish Board policy relating to safety and emergency plans at the College.

Safety is a high priority at Pasco-Hernando State College. Every effort will be made to continue to emphasize its importance. Annually, the College Safety and Security Committee will review and update, as appropriate, the College's safety and emergency procedures plans as a means of promoting a safe and secure environment at the College:

Safety Manual. The College's Safety Manual shall include plans to address issues pertinent to the maintenance of a safe working environment in compliance with all applicable federal and state laws.

Emergency Procedures Manual. The College's Emergency Procedures Manual shall include plans pertinent to effective preparation for and response to emergencies that may impinge upon the College. The provisions of the Manual shall be compliant with all applicable federal and state laws.

Provisions for appropriate and adequate training on safety and emergency procedures shall be provided to address specific issues identified in both the Safety Manual and the Emergency Procedures Manual.
