

6Hx19-3.33 COLLEGE PREPARATORY REMEDIATION ALTERNATIVES

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish Board policy regarding college preparatory remediation alternatives.

Upon request, students whose college placement test scores are below the State Board of Education designated cut-offs, as listed in Florida Administrative Code 6A-10.0315, *College Preparatory Testing, Placement, and Instruction*, will be advised of other schools, agencies, and/or educational services from both the public and private sectors that may provide remediation as an alternative to traditional college preparatory instruction. The student will be informed that following external vendor instruction, the College will reassess the student's academic levels, upon request. Students who choose these college preparatory remediation alternatives will be informed that these programs are not eligible for financial aid through the College. The College neither promotes specific programs nor guarantees that instruction provided by these vendors leads to college-level academic proficiency.
