

6Hx19-6.20 FUND-RAISING ACTIVITIES

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish Board policy for fund-raising activities that are internal to Pasco-Hernando State College.

The President has ultimate control of the College's fund-raising activities to ensure that all fund-raising activities support the College's priorities as established by the District Board of Trustees. The College's students and employees shall not raise funds for any College-related project or organization without prior approval from the President or designee and the Associate Vice President of Alumni and College Relations/Executive Director of the Foundation.

Fundraising activities which will benefit non-College entities, including charitable organizations, must be conducted in accordance with this Rule and must conform to the requirement of District Board of Trustees Rule 6Hx19-2.44 *Endorsements of Products or Services*.
