

## **6Hx19-6.26 VETERAN PROGRESS AND PROBATION**

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish Board policy regarding academic progress of students receiving veteran's benefits.

The President shall establish procedures for monitoring the academic progress of students who receive veteran's benefits, in accordance with the U.S. Department of Veterans' Affairs (VA) requirements. Students receiving VA benefits will be evaluated on their standards of academic progress (SAP). Veterans are expected to progress at a rate that will permit graduation within the approved length of the program based upon the training time paid by VA. Failure to comply with these provisions may result in the termination of educational benefits by the VA.

In the event that a student receiving veteran's benefits stops attending, withdraws, audits, or fails a class, the College is required to notify the VA of the veteran's last date of attendance. Faculty are required to note on the grade roster the last date of attendance for any VA student who does not successfully complete a course. Veteran's benefits may cease or be reduced based upon their class attendance
