

6Hx19-1.15 SUCCESSION TO PRESIDENTIAL AUTHORITY AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This policy establishes the succession to the President regarding College authority and responsibilities.

The incumbents of the following positions, in order, will succeed to the authority and responsibilities of the President during temporary absence or incapacity of the President:

1. Vice President, Academic Affairs/Chief Academic Officer;
2. Vice President, Student Services;
3. Vice President of Technology and Distance Education/Chief Information Officer;
4. Vice President of Policy, Budget and Administration;
5. Associate Vice President of Finance, Chief Financial Officer; and
6. Associate Vice President of Facilities.

This policy does not address situations where the absence of the President is permanent, whether voluntary or involuntary.
