

6Hx19-1.29 COPYRIGHT COMPLIANCE

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish Board policy regarding copyright compliance.

The College's students, faculty, administration, and staff are expected to comply with all laws regarding copyright and to act in good faith when using copyrighted materials.

The President shall establish procedures to ensure that the College's students, faculty, administration, and staff have a basic understanding and comply with copyright laws.

College employees are individually responsible for compliance with all copyright laws. College employees who willfully violate copyright laws may face fines, civil or criminal penalties, as well as disciplinary action by the College.
