

## **6Hx19-1.37 PUBLIC LECTURES, DISPLAYS, EXHIBITS, AND PRESENTATIONS**

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish Board policy regarding public lectures, displays, exhibits, and presentations.

Pasco-Hernando State College serves the educational needs and interests of its community. In support of its Mission, it shall be the policy of the College to permit public lectures, displays, exhibits, and presentations, outside of the normal classroom experience, as forums for expression. The President shall establish procedures for the application, authorization and scheduling of such forums. These procedures shall not abridge freedom of speech or be unreasonably restrictive on content. All such events shall be consistent with the mission of the College as set forth in District Board of Trustees Rule 6Hx19-1.16, College Vision Statement and Mission Statement.

This policy statement shall be applicable to extracurricular use of any facility, location, or medium owned and/or operated by the College.
