

6Hx19-1.40 STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE TO THE DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Purpose of this Rule is to establish policy for a Pasco-Hernando State College (PHSC) student to serve as a non-voting member on the College's District Board of Trustees (DBOT). The Student Representative shall be a liaison between the student body and the District Board of Trustees.

A currently enrolled PHSC student may serve as a non-voting student representative on the DBOT. The student representative shall be subject to annual appointment by the DBOT and may serve for a maximum of two one-year terms. The student may be appointed by a majority vote of the PHSC DBOT or through a competitive process and with confirmation by the DBOT.

The DBOT Chairperson may appoint a DBOT member to work with the Senior Vice-President of Student Affairs to establish the appropriate procedures regarding the selection of the student representative.
