

6Hx19-3.23 ACADEMIC HONORS

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish Board policy regarding academic honors.

A student will be placed on the President's Honors List when a 3.5 out of a possible 4.0 grade point average (GPA) has been earned while attempting at least 12 semester hours of college credit. A part-time student may be placed on the President's Honors List each time 12 semester hours of college credit have been accumulated with a GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale.

Any student graduating with an Associate in Arts Degree, Associate in Science Degree, or a Bachelor of Science Degree or a Bachelor of Applied Science Degree with a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or above in all college credit courses applicable toward a degree, including transfer credit hours, shall be graduated with honors.

The student or students with the highest grade point average in an Associate in Arts Degree, Associate in Science Degree, Bachelor of Science Degree, or a Bachelor of Applied Science Degree in any graduating class during the academic year, shall be designated as the "Honor Graduate with Highest Honors."
