

6Hx19-4.02 BONDING OF CONTRACTORS

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish Board policy relating to the bonding of contractors and other providers of construction services.

The President, or a designee, shall require contractors to furnish the District Board of Trustees with a performance and payment bond as set forth in Florida Statute 255.05.

The President may waive this requirement for contracts of \$200,000 or less provided there are other appropriate contractual mechanisms for ensuring timely performance and payment.

In lieu of a required bond, and with approval of the board, a contractor may provide an alternative form of security in the form of cash, money order, a certified check, a cashier's check, an irrevocable letter of credit, or a security of a type listed in part II of chapter 625, Florida Statutes.
