

6Hx19-4.12 OFFICIAL HOURS OF COLLEGE OPERATION AND UNAUTHORIZED TRESPASS

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish the official hours of operation of the College and unauthorized trespass.

The President is authorized to establish and post the official operating hours of the College. Any person not duly authorized, licensed, or invited by an official of the College to be on the premises or within any structure when the College is closed will be committing the offense of trespass and local law enforcement officials will be notified.

Due to public safety concerns, there will be no fishing, feeding wildlife, swimming, or boating on college property. Signs with this language will be posted around campus areas.

No person under the age of 18 who is not enrolled, attending or otherwise engaged in business with the College shall be on campus without being accompanied by and under the direct supervision of an adult.
