6Hx19-6.13: Code of Student Conduct and Disciplinary Policy

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish the Pasco-Hernando State College Code of Student Conduct and Student Disciplinary Policy. The College shall adopt a procedure for a student code of conduct and appropriate penalties for violations of rules or regulations by students, to be administered by the College. Such penalties, unless otherwise provided by law, may include: written warning, reprimand; monetary restitution and/or work/service restitution; temporary or permanent loss of privileges; probation; suspension; or expulsion.

The College shall adopt a code of conduct procedure and appropriate penalties for violations of rules or regulations by student organizations, to be administered by the College. Such penalties will be determined according to the level of misconduct, and unless otherwise provided by law, may include: reprimand; restitution; suspension, cancellation, or revocation of the registration or official recognition of a student organization; and restrictions on the use of, or removal from, campus facilities.

This policy and the College student code of conduct shall be subject to and governed by Florida Statute 1006.60. The College shall incorporate the additional provisions set forth in Florida Statute 1006.60 in the student code of conduct procedure, and the procedure shall be published on the College's website.
