

6HX19-6.15 STUDENT SUSPENSION AND DISMISSAL - HEALTH PROGRAMS

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish Board policy relating to the dismissal of students from health programs at the College.

Students enrolled in a health-related degree, certificate, or diploma program at the College may be dismissed from the program as established by the administration of the College in Internal Management Memorandum (IMM) #6-16, *Procedures for Student Suspension and Dismissal from Health Programs*, and as published in the *College Catalog/Student Handbook*.

The procedures established shall, at a minimum, ensure that the student is given an opportunity to be heard and that due process has been observed before a final determination regarding dismissal from the program. These procedures shall detail the reporting and investigative process to be followed by the College faculty and staff and by the student. Additionally, the procedures will set forth with as much specificity as possible the conduct that is prohibited under this rule. The College's President or designee shall authorize the faculty to provide for the immediate, temporary suspension of a student from clinical activities in appropriate circumstances as described in IMM #6-16, *Procedures for Student Suspension and Dismissal from Health Programs*.
