6Hx19-6.30 ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE ELIGIBILITY

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish Board policy regarding Associate in Arts Degree eligibility.

In accordance with Florida Statute 1007.263 with respect to Associate in Arts Degree registrations:

Admission to the Associate in Arts Degree Program is subject to minimum standards adopted by the State Board of Education and shall require:

A standard high school diploma or its equivalent. Students who are enrolled in a dual enrollment or early admission program pursuant to Florida Statute 1007.27 and secondary students enrolled in college-level instruction creditable toward the Associate Degree, but not toward the high school diploma, shall be exempt from this requirement.

A demonstrated level of achievement of college-level communication and computation skills, and

Any other requirements established by the District Board of Trustees.
