

6Hx19-6.30 ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE ELIGIBILITY

The purpose of this Board Rule is to establish Board policy regarding Associate in Arts Degree eligibility.

In accordance with Florida Statute 1007.263 with respect to Associate in Arts Degree registrations:

Admission to the Associate in Arts Degree Program is subject to minimum standards adopted by the State Board of Education and shall require:

A standard high school diploma, a high school equivalency diploma as prescribed in Florida Statute 1003.435, previously demonstrated competency in college credit postsecondary coursework, or, in the case of a student who is home educated, a signed affidavit submitted by the student's parent or legal guardian attesting that the student has completed a home education program pursuant to the requirements of Florida Statute 1002.41. Students who are enrolled in a dual enrollment or early admission program pursuant to Florida Statute 1007.271 are exempt from this requirement.

A demonstrated level of achievement of college-level communication and computation skills, and:

Any other requirements established by the District Board of Trustees.
