

6Hx19-9.04 CHARTER SCHOOL OVERSIGHT AND MONITORING FRAMEWORK

The purpose of this Policy is to establish the standards used by Pasco-Hernando State College (College) or its designee to oversee its sponsored charter schools. Ongoing oversight for college-sponsored charter schools is central to the autonomy and accountability that serves as the foundation for the vision, goals and authorizing priorities of the College. This ensures consistent expectations, promotes high-quality educational outcomes, and protects school autonomy across all sponsored schools.

The College, or its designee, shall maintain a comprehensive annual monitoring calendar outlining all required reporting deadlines, review windows, and oversight activities for each sponsored school.

The College, or its designee, shall conduct regular site visits and records reviews to ensure compliance in all domains (e.g., academics, finance, governance, safety) by sponsored charter schools. Enforcement actions will be guided by and proportionate to the severity, frequency, and impact of the identified deficiencies, and shall align with the College's responsibilities as an authorizer.

The governing board of each charter school shall report its progress annually to the College, and the College shall forward the report to the Commissioner of Education at the same time as other annual school accountability reports.

Procedures

The College is responsible for and authorized to adopt procedures necessary for implementing this Policy.
