

6Hx19-9.07 CHARTER SCHOOL ACCOUNTABILITY, ASSESSMENT, AND DATA REPORTING

This Policy establishes the governance framework for Pasco-Hernando State College (College) regarding accountability, assessment, and data reporting. In its capacity as the local education agency, the College ensures high academic standards and strict data integrity for the charter schools it sponsors.

The College will ensure that its contracted consultants or designees are authorized to maintain systems, procedures, and oversight mechanisms necessary to ensure charter school participation in Florida's accountability and assessment systems, including accurate submission of required data. Oversight shall focus on verification, coordination, and compliance assurance, and shall not involve direct operation of school-level instructional or data systems unless required by Florida's Department of Education.

Procedures

The College is responsible for and authorized to adopt procedures necessary for implementing this Policy.
