

6Hx19-9.09 CHARTER SCHOOL FEDERAL PROGRAMS GOVERNANCE

This Policy establishes the guidance by which Pasco-Hernando State College (College) fulfills its responsibilities as a local educational agency (LEA) for federal education programs administered on behalf of sponsored charter schools.

The College shall fulfill all LEA requirements for schools participating in federal programs, except for those schools that are designated to be their own LEA by the state of Florida and including the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (including the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act), the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, and the Carl D. Perkins Act.

The College or its designee, shall maintain the capacity, systems, and controls necessary to:

- a. Serve as the LEA for federal education programs supporting sponsored charter schools.
- b. Ensure compliance with applicable federal laws, regulations, and grant requirements.
- c. Monitor charter school implementation of federal programs and use of federal funds.
- d. Implement corrective actions and coordinate audit responses when deficiencies are identified.

The College is responsible for and authorized to adopt procedures necessary for implementing this Policy.
